MAINTENANCE LOAN

DISABLED STUDENTS' ALLOWANCE (DSA)

ADULT DEPENDANTS' GRANT

A non-repayable grant to help students who have an adult who depends on them.

CHILDCARE GRANT

A means-tested grant with up to 85% of childcare costs covered
