Do you want a career in Nursing (Adult, Child, Mental Health or Disability), Midwifery, Radiography, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Sports Therapy, Sports Science, Biomedical Science, Psychology, Dental Health and Hygiene, Paramedic Science or Operational Department Practice (Theatre Management)? Our Fast Track to University course for those aged 19+ can get you on the relevant Degree in 1 year. If you take out an Advanced Learner Loan to fund this course, then go on to complete a Higher Education course, you'll be eligible to have the balance of your Advanced Learner Loan written off. However, if you don't complete either course, you won't be eligible to have the balance written off, and will need to repay your loan in full.
