Level 2 Certificate in the Principles of Plant Growth, Propagation and Development (Theory) Level 2 (4 units) comprising:

- Soil – Physical Properties/Soil – Organic Matter
- Maintaining Plant Health
- Understanding Plant Propagation

Certificate in the Principles of Garden Planning, Establishment and Maintenance (Theory) Level 2 (4 units) comprising:

- Garden Features & Planning/Plant Selection & Planning
- Plant Choice, Establishment & Maintenance
- The Production of Outdoor Vegetables/The Production of Top & Soft Fruit
- Understanding Protected Environments & Horticultural uses

Entry Requirements

 - Basic IT skills and access to a computer and/or laptop with internet access are required. Access to the online classroom is available on PC and IOS and Android operating systems
- Completion of Level 1 is not necessary, most learners can begin at Level 2.
