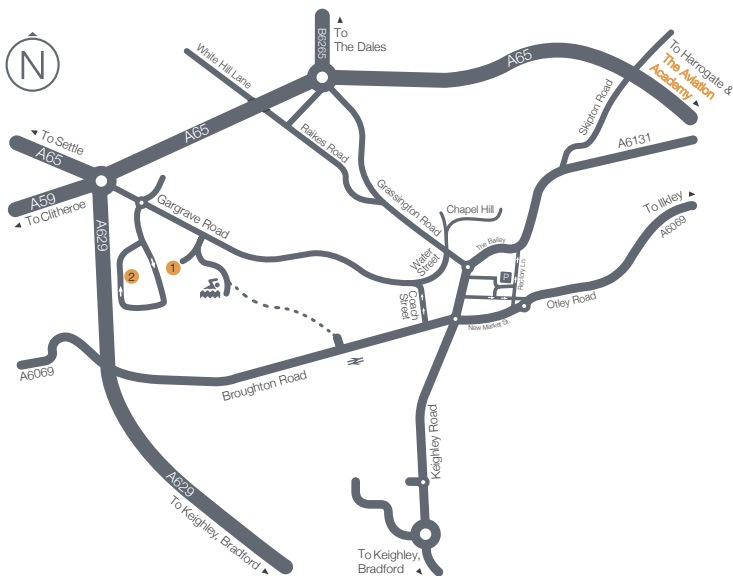

Welcome to Craven College's 2020-21 School Leavers' Guide showcasing our Apprenticeships and Vocational courses. Full course details can be found on our website at www.craven-college.ac.uk.

We are an aspirational College, set in friendly, rural campuses in Skipton within the beautiful Yorkshire Dales and at The Aviation Academy based at Leeds Bradford Airport.

Approximately 1,600 full-time (as well as a further 4,500 part-time) students choose to study here each year primarily from Craven, East Lancashire and the Wharfe and Aire Valleys. The Aviation Academy attracts students nationally for our aviation-related courses.

Our £1.6m Animal Management Centre on the Aireville Campus (opened 2018) has extended the high-quality provision for Animal Management students. 2020 will see the construction of new Equine facilities including an international sized arena and outdoor warm-up area. Equine students will benefit from increased stabling for College horses, events including dressage, showjumping, arena eventing and showing along with masterclasses, training and clinics to be delivered by industry professionals.

Don't forget that we also offer Degrees, so if you prefer to stay at home and want a good quality alternative to university, you have an option to continue your studies with us.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

1. SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION ONLINE



If it is the first time you have used the Craven College Application system, you must register first

Please make a note of your email address and password, you will need this to log back on to the application system and submit further details during the application process. All correspondence will be sent to the email address you registered with.

2. VISIT AN OPEN EVENING



Get an idea of what the College is like, and speak to tutors teaching on your course. (see page 2)

3. WE WILL SEND YOU AN OFFER



Offers will be sent to the email address you registered with and you can log in to the Application System to accept your offer. Offers are usually conditional, which means they are based on the assumption of you achieving the relevant GCSEs.

If you have applied for an Apprenticeship you will be invited for an interview to discuss the course and get you started in finding a suitable employer if you do not already have one.



4. ACCEPT YOUR OFFER

Decide if you are happy with your offer and accept to secure your place. Accept your offer online via the Application System.

An offer of an Apprenticeship will be subject to gaining employment within the industry. Applicants for Apprenticeships will be advised to apply for a full time course as an alternative in case they are unsuccessful in finding work.



5. COMPLETE THE SUPPORT NEEDS QUESTIONNAIRE

Let us know if you have any additional support needs so we can help you during your time at Craven College. You can update and submit your support needs on the online Application System.



6. RECEIVE ENROLMENT INFORMATION

During July you will receive a letter telling you when and where to come to enrol on your chosen course and what kit and equipment you will need.



7. ENROL

Enrolment takes place on GCSE results day and the day after.

If you have secured an Apprenticeship, you will not need to come and enrol. Just let us know when you are starting and we will come to your workplace to do all the paperwork and get you started.

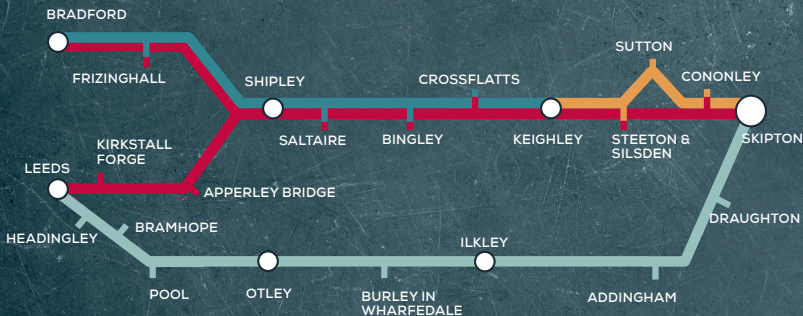
TRAVEL

DISCRETIONARY LEARNER SUPPORT FUND

This bursary is available to help with up to 50% of the cost of essential kit, equipment and uniform. Assistance from this fund is available to students with a household income of £21,000 (gross) per year or below.

CHILDCARE

For those who are aged 20+ at the start of their course and have a household income of £21,000 or less, we can offer childcare support. Childcare costs can only be considered up to a maximum of £125 per week (one child) or £175 per week (more than one child). Childcare must be provided by an Ofsted registered childcare provider.

LUNCH VOUCHERS

Students with a household income of £16,190 or less will be eligible for lunch vouchers. Students will receive £3 to spend in The College Café or at a College approved supplier.

CARE TO LEARN

Care to Learn is a government scheme offering childcare support for students who are 19 or under at the start of their course. For further information please visit:

ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION

If you are aged 19 or older and looking for an alternative route of study to get back into education to prepare for university or professional training, then the Access to HE course will allow you to progress with like-minded people in a mature and professional environment. We support mature students with few formal qualifications but with life experience, and help to create pathways to life-changing opportunities. Many adults have the potential and ability to study for a Degree or professional qualification but have been unable to do so because their education was disrupted due to family, financial, social or personal circumstances. You will be given support and guidance throughout the UCAS application process so that when you have completed the course you can move straight onto your chosen Degree.

Our £1.6m Animal Management Centre, opened in 2018, provides a sensational extension to our high-quality provision for Animal Studies students. The facilities include a reception area with a large display tank for large reptiles, specialist rooms for fish, invertebrates, nocturnals, rabbits, guinea pigs, reptiles, amphibians, small mammals, plus quarantine and isolation rooms. There is a dedicated dog exercise area and grooming room as well as outdoor and indoor aviaries, outdoor runs for ducks, hens, geese and rabbits and a wildlife area.

Our Animal Studies tutors have a vast range of skills and years of experience of working with animals, including dog grooming in the UK and caring for reptiles as part of private zoo collections. Their specialist study areas include animal health and nutrition, animal health and parasitology, animal behaviour, conservation and ecology, giving you a depth of knowledge to tap into.

Visits to zoos and local farms and frequent workshops by local experts are some of the enrichment activities you can expect to be part of the Animal Studies course at Craven College.

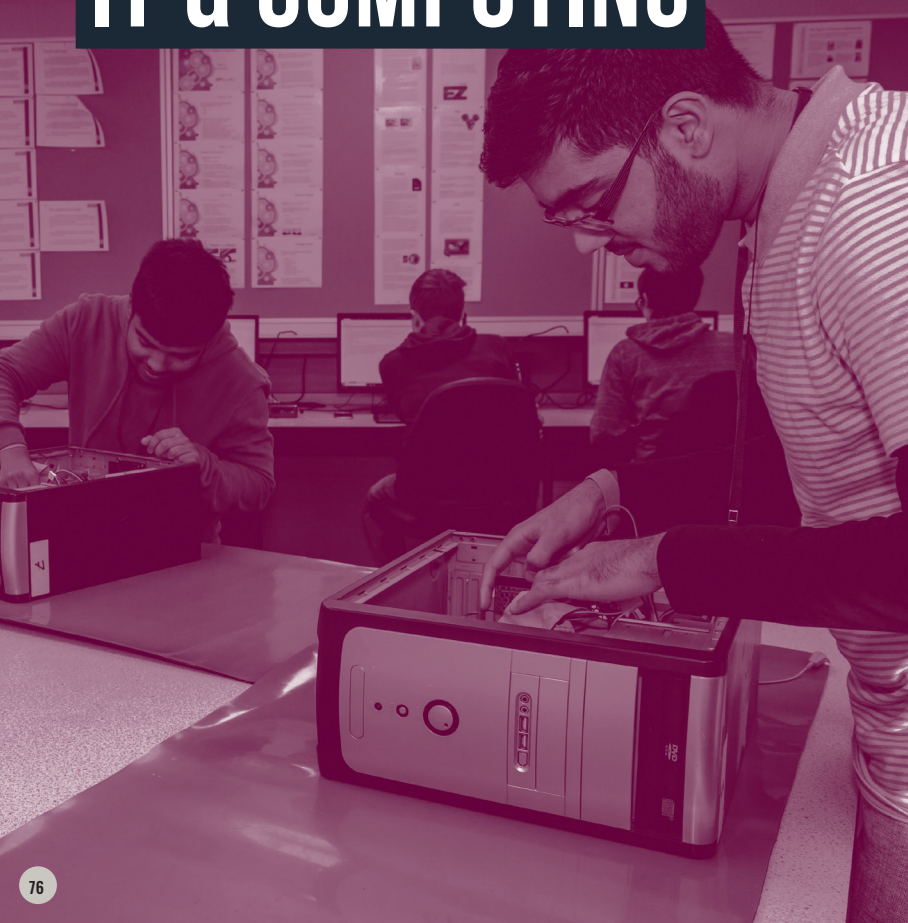
