Phonetic Alphabet

Find out the words used to substitute each letter of the alphabet A-Z eg A = Alpha and the numbers 0-9 eg 3 = tree

Try to use objects in your home or when out on your daily exercise rather than internet pictures. Use your family as models. You could even use a range of images to depict 1 image such as Tango (Tan - a person sunbathing and Go - a road sign). Be imaginative!
