### Phonetic Alphabet

Information communicated in aviation often has similar names, letters or numbers. To avoid confusion, the phonetic alphabet is used when giving messages that include letters or numbers. Find out the words used to substitute each letter of the alphabet A-Z eg A = Alpha and the numbers 0-9 eg 3 = tree

Then show this information in picture format in a poster format or social media platform that can be shared. Try to use objects in your home or when out on your daily exercise rather than internet pictures. Use your family as models. You could even use a range of images to depict 1 image such as Tango (Tan - a person sunbathing and Go - a road sign). Be imaginative!
