Parent / Student Briefing - Results days

Update for A Level and GCSE exam results:

You will have heard the announcement from the Department of Education (DfE) which came out late last night about its 'triple lock' plan. This can be read [here](#) but key points are detailed below. Under the triple lock plan students can either accept their calculated grade, resit exams in Autumn or appeal to receive a valid mock result.

The regulatory body for exams and assessment, Ofqual, has been asked to determine how and when valid mock results can be used to calculate grades.

Students who would like to use a valid mock result will be able to do so through the appeals process, with individuals notifying their school or college who will provide evidence of their mock results to their exam board.

We are still waiting for further information from Ofqual and the awarding bodies about their appeals process in relation to mock results and we will update you as soon as we receive further guidance.

Similar arrangements will apply to vocational and technical qualifications and again we are waiting for more information from the DfE on this.

I do want to reassure that if you are progressing within the College or are new to College, we will be taking all of the recent upheaval into account and ensure that you can continue your educational journey.
